## Code of Conduct



At Yarburgh Community Preschool we believe that children reach their full potential and flourish best in an ordered, calm environment where parents, carers, ourselves and any outside agencies all work together. We encourage close links with parents and the community and believe that we all benefit when the relationship between home and preschool is a positive one.

## Yarburgh expectations

We encourage the children to:

- be helpful and kind to all children and adults within the setting
- respect and look after the toys and resources that we use
- be careful and safe when using equipment indoors and outdoors
- listen to our friends and adults within the setting

## Parent/carers expectations

We ask parents, carers and visitors to follow these guidance points to keep our preschool environment safe and welcoming for everyone. Please refrain from:

- using aggressive or offensive language or behaviour
- using language of a prejudicial nature including, but not limited to, homophobia, racism, nationalism and negative religious comments.
- using threats or physical aggression towards anyone
- damaging preschool property
- sending abusive messages (email, text, social media)
- being under the influence of alcohol or drugs when on preschool property
- smoking or vaping on preschool property

## Social media and online activity

Please refrain from:

- posting photos or videos of children without permission
- posting abusive or personal comments about staff, our committee, children or other parents.
- using social media to publicly challenge preschool policies or discuss issues about individual children or members of staff. Please follow our complaints procedure if you have a concern.
